

## **SDSPLS GRANT PROGRAM GUIDELINES**

### **PURPOSE:**

The purpose of the Grant Program is to support surveying education in South Dakota, to reach more students and individuals, and to enhance their surveying education experience.

### **WHO CAN APPLY:**

South Dakota School Instructors, Mentors, or LSIT instructors may apply for a grant to assist in surveying activities, field trips, equipment rental, travel, mentoring activity or workshop, hotel stays, etc. Activities are not limited to those listed here. Mentoring and LSIT instructors must be SDSPLS members.

### **ABOUT THE GRANT(S):**

\$5000 fund per funding period (subject to change per yearly budgets).  
Funding will be determined based on the project(s), application(s) and amount(s) requested.

Grants may be applied for on a yearly basis.

The SDSPLS Board of Directors BOD has the discretion to award additional funding.

### **AWARDS:**

Grants will be awarded at the discretion of the SDSPLS Board of Directors.  
Reimbursements will be mailed directly to the contact individual for the specified program or activity.

### **REQUIREMENTS:**

Completed application including:

- Contact individual and information.

- Activity and activity description

- Number of individuals or students involved and to what levels

- Estimated cost of activity

- The amount of funding requested

- List what other sources of funding (as applicable)

- Identify the name of the individual or entity to receive the funding (payable to:)

Applications must be postmarked by September 1 of given year
